



## DRAWING AND PAINTING WITH ENAMELS Taught by Rebekah Laskin

### Student supplies:

- 2 pieces 3"x3" square copper sheet, plus extra copper sheet for additional sample pieces in 20-22 gauge
- Alundum stone 150 or 220 grit
- Assorted brushes, size 0-000
- Ceramic palette and/or small plastic containers for water, etc.
- Colored pencils, Prismacolor are good
- Anything else you like to draw with—marker, watercolour, pen, etc. (optional)
- #2 pencil and mechanical pencil
- Scissors or matt knife and cutting surface
- Assorted Thompson enamels including:
  - 8 oz. 1055 white
  - 8 oz. 2020 clear for silver
  - 2 or 3 light transparent colors such as Russet brown, copper green, nitric blue -2 oz.
  - 3 or 4 opaque colors, good variety -2 oz.
- 1 sheet fine silver foil SF-1
- Dust mask
- 2" sifter SM-3
- 200 mesh sifter or 200 mesh screen to make sifter
