



## FOCUS FAQ

**Q: Is there a deadline?**

**A:** You should declare your intent to complete a certificate after completing your first session of classes at BKMW, and before the session you wish to count towards your certificate begins.

**Q: Do I need to apply?**

**A:** You do not need to apply to join the program. You can declare your intent to complete one or both certificates by emailing us at [info@bkmetalworks.com](mailto:info@bkmetalworks.com).

**Q: What is the fee?**

**A:** There is a one time fee of \$250 to declare enrollment in the program.

**Q: Is there a discount?**

**A:** No. For discounts on classes and workshops at BKMW consider becoming a member or a resident artist. Focus students do get access to early enrollment.

**Q: What if I took my introductory classes at another studio or in college?**

**A:** This is decided on a case-by-case basis. Please contact us to schedule a meeting to discuss your prior experience. We will want to discuss:

1. What you learned in past courses.
2. The duration of the course(s).
4. If you have been continuing your studio practice.
3. How long you might have been out of the studio.

**Q: Can I do both certificates?**

**A:** Of course! Overlapping class requirements would only need to be taken once. You will, however, need to attend twice as many workshops and lectures to qualify for both certificates.

**Q: How long do I have to finish the certificate?**

**A:** You have four years from the time that you first declare.

**Q: What is the total cost of the program?**

**A:** As of 2020, the total cost for registration and required classes is under \$7000, not including tools, space, and materials.

**Q: Will it fill up?**

**A:** No, there is no class limit.
